



## French Creek Council's Trip to the 2010 National Scout Jamboree

### Travel Plans:

The French Creek Council is planning on attending the 2010 National Scout Jamboree by leaving Custaloga Town around the end of July at around 10PM and travel by motor bus to the National Jamboree. On route, we plan to stop and tour Washington DC for a day before arriving at the National Scout Jamboree celebrating 100 years of Scouting in America. We will then spend the next several days attending the National Jamboree. After the National Jamboree, we plan to travel to King's Dominion Amusement Park and spend an entire day in the park. The park is a large park with many rides and attractions. Finally we will return to Custaloga Town early the next morning.

### Organization:

The National Jamboree French Creek Council trip is open to all who are qualified on a first come basis. After our contingents have been filled up a waiting list will be established. **You don't want to miss this opportunity so sign up now.** The French Creek Council will be sending at least three contingents to start (a contingent is 36 scouts and 4 adults or a total of 108 scouts and 12 adults). You will be a member of one of these contingents as a patrol. The French Creek Council will consist of three troops.

### Total Cost:

The total cost for each scout will be \$2010.00. (\$2000.00 plus the \$10.00 National process fee). This fee will include all transportation costs, tours, admission fees, meals, lodging, pre-jamboree training, patches, jamboree specific uniform parts, footlocker, patrol and troop equipment, and so much more. The only expense you will need is your spending money and your personal items. Applications and requirements to attend are available now on the council website.

### The Jamboree Itself:

The National Jamboree program itself is Scouting to the extreme. Plan on spending several days in all kinds of activities and events. Activities in many areas from biking to shooting sports to pioneering and climbing. Every merit badge can be earned! There is so much to do at the Jamboree that is so hard to explain it here.
