

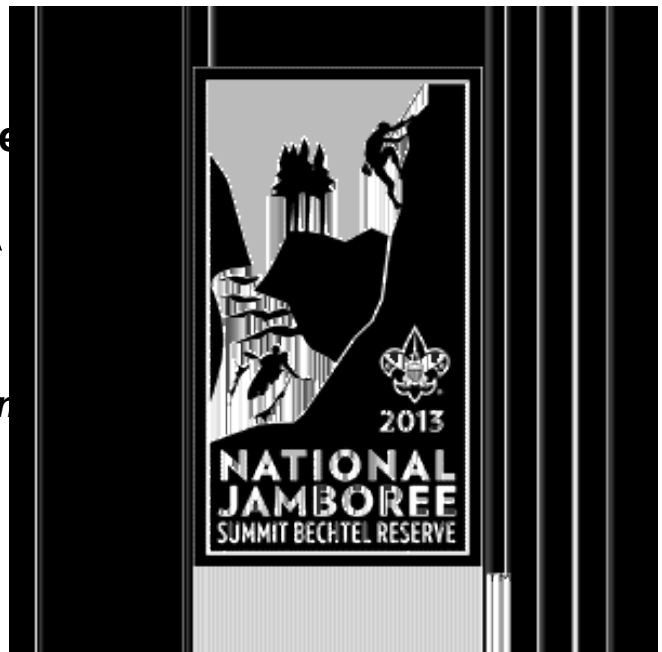

- ❖ Have filed a Jamboree personal Health and Medical record with the council jamboree committee before the pre-jamboree training
- ❖ Submit all registration fees per local council's payment schedule

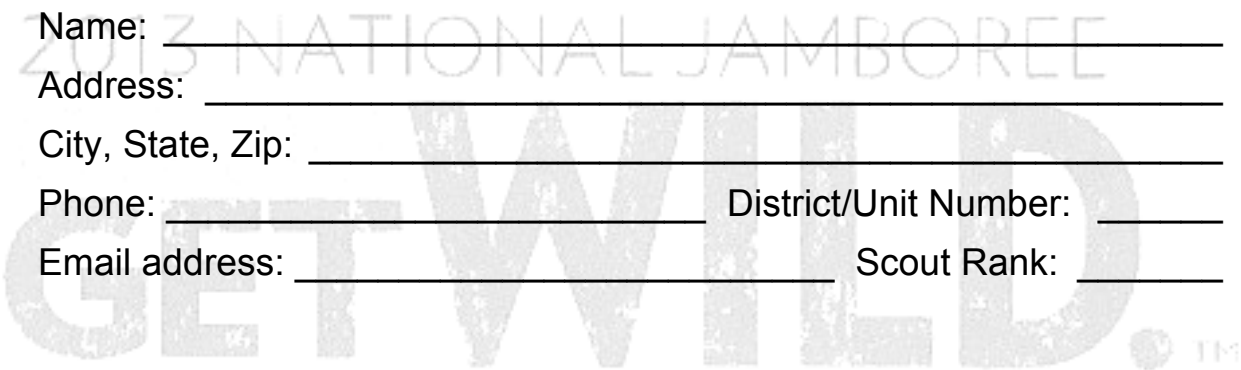
