Registration will begin promptly at 8:15. Opening ceremony begins at 9:00.

What is the Training Extravaganza? The Training Extravaganza is a one-day training designed to provide ideas and resources to enhance the program of your Pack, Troop, Post or Crew.

Who attends the Training Extravaganza? All Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venture and Explorer Leaders, all other Scout Volunteers and Scout Parents. You do not have to be a registered Leader to attend. Troops, Posts and Crews may bring their youth leaders.

Youth Leaders must be accompanied by an adult and may take any course offered.

What will I do at the Training Extravaganza? HAVE FUN! LEARN NEW AND EXCITING IDEAS! LEARN NEW SKILLS! MEET SCOUT LEADERS, AND MAKE NEW FRIENDS FROM FRENCH CREEK AND NEIGHBORING COUNCILS!

Each course is designed to help you prepare to provide a quality program for your Scouts.

You choose courses that interest you, or provide needed information, to fill a 6 period day.

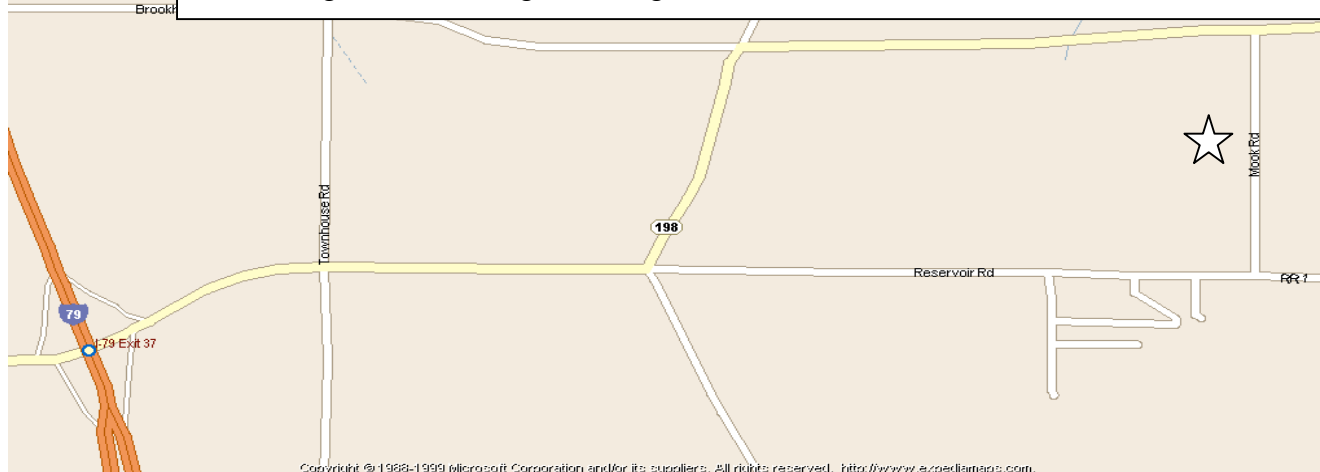
Course descriptions include a rating that indicates the program level the course is designed for:

BS-Boy Scout **CS**- Cub Scout **V**-Venturing **E** - Everyone **NL(S)**- New Leader (Specific)

YOU MAY TAKE ANY COURSE OFFERED, REGARDLESS OF YOUR SCOUTING POSITION.

Courses are assigned on a “first come- first served” basis. Early registration is essential to ensure you get your desired courses. Courses have a minimum/maximum number of participants allowed. Unforeseen circumstances may cause a course to be cancelled. **It is essential that you indicate on the registration form your second choice for each period.** You must provide an E-mail Address to receive confirmation of your processed Registration form.

FROM INTERSTATE 79: Take Exit 154 - PA 198 (Saegertown/Conneautville) towards SAEGERTOWN. Turn EAST on PA 198 and travel approximately 2.2 miles. Turn RIGHT onto MOOK ROAD. Saegertown High School will be on the RIGHT in approximately 3/10 mile. Follow signs for Parking and Registration.

You will need to bring a lunch, or use the area providers.

REGISTRATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

1. Select the classes you want, up to six periods. Note: some classes are more than 1 period long.
2. Select a second choice in case we cannot give you your first choice. All participants will receive their schedule when they complete the Registration Check-in.

NOTE: The 1st choice for Period One is a two period course; therefore a 1st choice for period two is not needed. A 2nd choice for BOTH periods should be indicated.

3. Fill out the personal information **COMPLETELY**: Name; address, including City, State Zip Code; Phone Number; Unit type and number; BSA ID Number (9 digit number found on your BSA Registration Card); Council and District; and form of payment. **Include your E-mail address, if you want to be notified that your registration has been processed. PLEASE!!!! Fill out both sides of the registration form completely.**

Registration Fees Per Person

Includes Attendance, Event Patch, Training Card(s), Liability Insurance, and Administrative Costs.

\$15.00 for ON-TIME REGISTRATION - Registration Form and payment must be received at the McGarvey Service Center **before NOON** on November 4, 2011.

\$20.00 for WALK-INS (from NOON on November 4, 2011 throughout the Event). Those registering at the Training Extravaganza will need to choose their courses from those still available. You may be unable to complete registration in time to attend the Opening Ceremony.

FAMILY DISCOUNT: 2 people = \$25.00 3 people = \$37.50 4 people = \$50.00

A \$2.50 per person discount will apply for families. To qualify for family discount the participants **must live AT THE SAME ADDRESS**. *Example:* If a husband, wife and their 1st Class Scout attend, \$2.50 per person may be deducted from the cost. Instead of paying an On-Time Registration fee totaling \$45, the cost would be \$37.50 (\$12.50 each).
